One child, five connected areas of growth.

Physical

Movement, coordination, self-care, sensory awareness and healthy routines.

Emotional

Trust, confidence, feelings language, self-regulation and resilience.

Social

Friendship, communication, cooperation, empathy and belonging.

Academic

Language, literacy, math, science, reasoning and kindergarten readiness.

Creative

Art, music, dramatic play, construction, imagination and expression.

How it grows by age

Infants

Secure relationships, sensory exploration, early communication and responsive care.

Toddlers and Twos

Language, independence, movement, repetition, pretend play and social beginnings.

Preschool

Classroom routines, peer play, early concepts, curiosity and creative problem-solving.

Pre-K

Kindergarten readiness, independence, collaboration, early literacy, math reasoning and confidence.

Daily visibility

Families can see classroom moments through daily updates, photos and teacher notes.

Progress conversations

Teachers use observations and progress reports to talk about strengths, emerging skills and next supports.

Home connection

Simple home activities can help families continue the same kind of growth in everyday routines.

Teacher support

Classroom leaders and curriculum teams help teachers plan with care and respond to each classroom's needs.
